RE: DOCKET NO. 980951-TC - Petition of Global Tel*Link Corporation for exemption from order, rules, and regulations prohibiting termination of conversations after ten minutes on calls placed from pay telephones located in confinement institutions.

Issue 1: Should the Commission grant Global's petition for an exemption from the provisions of Rule 25-24.515(5) and 25-24.515(15), Florida Administrative Code, which prohibit termination of conversations after ten (10) minutes on calls placed from pay telephones located in confinement institutions?

Recommendation: Yes. Global's petition should be granted, however, Global should still adhere to the audible and written notification requirements of Rule 25-24.515 (5), Florida Administrative Code.

Issue 2: Should this docket be closed?

Recommendation: Yes. This docket should be closed unless a person whose substantial interests are affected by the Commission's decision files a protest within 21 days of issuance of the proposed agency action order. A protest filed by a local exchange company shall be applicable only to that local exchange company's territory and shall not prevent Global Tel*Link from terminating conversations after ten minutes on calls placed from pay telephones located in confinement institutions.
