Intermedia plans to serve discovery on BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. to more fully develop its position regarding this matter. Intermedia's preliminary comments are set forth below.

The Telecommunications Act of 1996 (Act) in Section 251(c)(6) requires incumbent local exchange carriers (ILECs) to provide physical collocation unless the carrier demonstrates to the state commission that physical collocation is not practical for technical


LEG 1 Intermedia believes that it is essential to allow competing
