Dear Ms. Bayo:

This letter responds to certain requests made by Commission Staff and Commissioner Jacobs at the September 28 prehearing conference in this matter.

First, GTE Florida Incorporated (GTEFL) will stipulate to entry into the record of the items included on Staff's draft Exhibit List distributed at the prehearing conference.

Second, Commissioner Jacobs asked for a description of the respective areas of expertise for witnesses who will testify on a panel. As I mentioned at the prehearing conference, Drs. Murphy and Tardiff will appear as a panel. Both witnesses will critique the HAI Model. Dr. Murphy principally addresses the engineering problems with the Model, while Dr. Tardiff focuses more on the economic flaws in the Model. However, Dr. Tardiff also speaks to certain engineering aspects of the HAI Model. In practice, it is sometimes difficult to neatly divide the two subject areas. GTE's experience in other states, however, is that the panel testimony goes quite smoothly.
