PETITION FOR APPROVAL OF FLORIDA PUBLIC UTILITIES COMPANY'S PURCHASED GAS ADJUSTMENT RECOVERY FACTOR

Florida Public Utilities Company ("FPU"), by and through its undersigned counsel submits this Petition for the approval of a Purchased Gas Adjustment Recovery Factor ("PGA factor") of 49.397 cents-per-therm for the period January 1999 through December 1999. In support of its Petition, FPU states as follows:



- 3. The Commission has directed Florida's natural gas public utilities to recover their purchased gas costs through a levelized purchase gas cost factor.¹ In accordance with Order Nos. 24463 and PSC-93-1783-FOF-GU, FPU has prepared and filed direct testimony² and composite exhibit GMB-2³ in support of its proposed PGA factor of 49.397 cents-oper-therm.
- 4. As demonstrated in the direct testimony and exhibit GMB-2, the final purchased gas adjustment true-up amount for the period April 1997 through March 1998 is an under-recovery of \$516,932 and the estimated purchased gas adjustment true-up amount for the period April 1998 through December 1998 is an over-recovery of \$783,287.
- Based upon its projected sales, FPU projects that the net over-recovery to be refunded during the period January 1999 through December 1999 is \$266,305, and FPU's appropriate PGA factor for the period January 1999 through December 1999 is a maximum of 49.397 cents-per-therm.
- FPU's approved PGA factor should be effective for all meter readings on or after
 January 1, 1999, beginning with the first or applicable billing cycle for the period January 1999.

WHEREFORE, Florida Public Utilities Company requests the Commission to approve FPU's purchased gas cost recovery factor of 49.397 cents-per-therm to be applied to customer bills for the period January 1999 through December 1999, and to billings thereafter until such time as another recovery factor is approved by the Commission.
