Dear Sir/Madam:

This is to advise you that Athena International will soon cease to be a functioning entity. As such, arrangements are being made to terminate all one-plus long distance services. The following is the text of a letter sent to all active One-Plus customers advising them of this fact.

"On October 5, 1998, Athena International shall discontinue your 1+ and/or Travel Card Long Distance Telecommunication Services. The cessation of these services will occur at 12:45 am on Monday, October 5, 1998, in order to minimize disruption during regular business hours.

"Prior to October 5, 1998, you will need to contact your local exchange carrier, local phone company or an alternative toll service provider to request a transfer of these telecommunication services to another long distance communications provider. The telephone numbers and addresses for such service transfer requests are located in the phone services pages of your local Yellow Pages. The directory to Phone Services will contain information regarding ordering new service, changes or disconnecting service and billing questions and will provide direct information for residential or billing services from alternative carriers such as AT&T, MCI, Sprint and others.

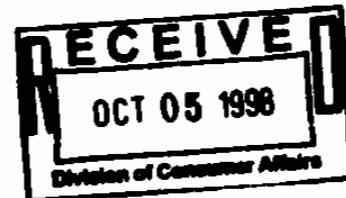
"If you do not make the requested transfer of your long distance telecommunications services by October 5, 1998, your services will be subject to automatic termination.

"This notice applies to your long distance services only and in no way will effect your local telecommunication services.

"While Athena International is making every effort to avoid disruption in service and/or to avoid a change in your price structure, such disruptions and/or price changes are unavoidable. Athena International thanks you for your use of Athena International services in the past."
