Hudson Utilities, Inc. d/b/a Hudson Bay Company (Hudson Bay or utility) is a Class B utility located in Pasco County. Hudson Bay was granted Certificate No. 104-S on June 19, 1973. The utility serves approximately 1259 residential and 80 commercial customers. According to the most recent information available, Hudson Bay's 1997 annual report filed with this Commission, the utility had annual operating revenues of \$793,845 and a net loss of \$127,538.

On August 26, 1998, Hudson Bay filed an application with this Commission for acknowledgment of a change in the name to Hudson Utilities, Inc., dropping the d/b/a Hudson Bay Company. The application shows that there is no change in the ownership or control of the utility or its assets.

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Section 2.07(C)(3), Administrative Procedures Manual, grants the Director of the Division of Records and Reporting, in coordination with the appropriate industry division and the Division of Legal Services, the authority to approve changes of names of regulated utilities where no change of ownership or control or transfer of assets is involved. As stated in the application, the ownership, control and assets of the utility will not change under the new name.

Staff finds the application in compliance with all provision of Rule 25-30.039, Florida Administrative Code, and recommends that an administrative order be issued approving the change of name for Certificate No. 582-W to Hudson Utilities, Inc. Staff recommends that the order approve the utility's proposed customer notice and require that the notice be sent to all utility customers upon issuance of the administrative order. Staff also recommends that the utility's proposed wastewater tariff be approved and become effective for services provided or connections made on or after the stamped approval date on the tariff sheets. Furthermore, staff recommends that this docket be closed.

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
