PGS's Position:

\$1,014,745 overrecovery.

Issue 2: What is the estimated purchased gas adjustment true-up amount for the period April 1998 through December 1998?

PGS's Position:

\$804,877 underrecovery.

Issue 3: What is the total purchased gas adjustment true-up amount to be refunded in the January 1999 - December 1999 period?

PGS's Position:

\$209,981 overrecovery.

<u>Issue 4</u>: What is the appropriate levelized purchased gas recovery (cap) factor to be charged during the period January 1999 through December 1999?

PGS's Position:

49.786 cents per therm.
