PERIOD FOR ACTIVITIES:

July, August, and September 1998

PROGRAM STATUS:

The FPL Green Pricing Research and Development Project (GPRDP) was approved by the Commission in Order No. PSC-97-FOF-0528-EG, dated May 7, 1997. This program is designed to allow FPL the flexibility to test FPL customer response to a Green Pricing Initiative. Under the GPRDP, FPL will solicit contributions from its customers to be used to purchase, install, maintain, and operate Photovoltaic (PV) modules on FPL's system.

FPL has continued the education and solicitation campaign for the project.

ACTIVITIES CONDUCTED:

1. FPL mailed out bill inserts with the continued story of the "Solar Research Partnership" to all residential customers during the July billing cycle.
2. FPL mailed out bill inserts with the story of the "Solar Research Partnership" to all general small commercial/industrial customers during the July billing cycle.
3. FPL continued discussions with the Florida Solar Energy Center on optimizing the design specifications for the actual photovoltaic facility and maximize the generation output for the level of funding received.
