This letter is in response to your letter addressed to Mr. Hill, dated October 19, 1998. In that letter, you requested that the Commission waive \$62,688.23 of \$128,496.17 in delinquent regulatory assessment fees, penalties, interest, and penalties associated with delinquent annual reports, to facilitate pending sales of A. P. Utilities, Inc., systems. Pursuant to Florida Statutes, the Commission has no authority to waive the penalty and interest on regulatory assessment fees. While the Commission could consider a petition for rule waiver on the penalties associated with annual reports filed by you, the time to ask for such consideration expired when you failed to respond to all of the Commission's orders to show cause.
