DOCUMENT NUMBER-DATE

1. On December 7, 1994, FCWC filed with the Commission an Application for Extension of Service Area in Lee County, which requested approval to extend FCWC's certificated water and wastewater territory to include certain service areas to which FCWC had inadvertently extended service outside of its certificated territory as well as certain prospective customers adjacent to such areas. Gulf Utility Company (Gulf) filed an objection to said application insofar as it sought to add to FCWC's certificated water territory any part of Section 9, Township 46 South, Range 25 East, on the grounds that such section was located within Gulf's certificated water territory. FCWC was providing water service to two adjacent buildings through one 5/8" meter within said Section 9, to wit, 8782 Alico Road and 8774 Alico Road, Fort Myers, Florida 33912-5117, known as the Alico International Trade Center (Alico). FCWC and Gulf subsequently entered into a Settlement Agreement under which Gulf would replace FCWC as Alico's water service provider. Alico thereafter objected to the Settlement Agreement on the grounds that Alico would thereunder have to pay higher service availability charges for Gulf's water service. FCWC, Gulf and Alico therefore entered into an Amended Settlement Agreement which was subsequently approved by the Commission by Order No.

- 6. The Alico property, as currently served by FCWC, consists of two adjacent buildings receiving water service through one 5/8" meter, and represents one (1) equivalent residential connection (ERC).
- 7. As a result of the passage of time and numerous personnel changes, FCWC is unable to verify the precise circumstances under which water service was extended outside its certificated service area to Alico. FCWC itself notified the Commission of this irregularity by its amendment application filed in Docket No. 941271-WS.
- 8. FCWC has the financial and technical ability to continue to provide water service to Alico. FCWC is a large, multi-county operation in the State of Florida, and has been in the water utility business since 1965. FCWC's operations are financially well supported and the technical support and expertise are firmly in place. The proposed extension would not have any impact in that regard.
 - Alico continues to need uninterrupted water service.
- 10. There are no existing facilities within the immediate geographical area capable of providing water service to Alico.

- 17. Alico is served through a sixteen (16") inch water main. This one (1) ERC requires approximately 300 gallons per day (gpd). The existing main has sufficient capacity to accommodate this flow.
- 18. The Florida Department of Environmental Protection has issued the following permits for the systems serving Alico:

- 19. No construction will be required on the part of FCWC for continuing water service to Alico, nor would there be any adverse impact on FCWC's capital structure, monthly rates, or service availability changes.
 - 20. Alico is a commercial (general service) water customer.
- 21. Proposed tariff sheets, which include the proposed extension, are attached as Composite Exhibit "8".
- 22. Certificate No. 27-W is identified as Exhibit 9 and has been furnished directly to Commission Staff.
- 23. (a) Pursuant to Rule 25-30.030(2), Florida

 Administrative Code, FCWC obtained from the Commission a list of

governmental authorities and certificated water utilities located within the County in which the proposed extension is located.

- (b) FCWC will provide a copy of a Notice by regular mail to the governmental authorities and certificated utilities required under Rule 25-30.030(5)(a) through (h), Florida Administrative Code, as listed on the document referred to in paragraph 23(a) hereinabove. This notice will be given no later than seven days after the date the application is filed.
- (c) FCWC will provide a copy of a Notice by regular mail to Alico, the customer to be served by the proposed extension, pursuant to Rule 25-30.030(6), Florida Administrative Code. This notice will be given no later than seven days after the date the application is filed.
- (d) Arrangements have been made with the Fort Myers

 News Press, a newspaper of general circulation in the territory

 proposed to be added, to publish the Notice. The publication of

 notice is expected no later than seven days after the date the

 application is filed.
- 24. Water rates and charges for the South Ft. Myers system were last amended by Orders Nos. 16768 and 16918. Water rates were also the subject of an index increase implemented in July, 1994.

25. An affidavit that FCWC has tariffs and annual reports on file with the Commission is attached hereto as Exhibit "10".

Based on the foregoing FCWC requests that Certificate

No. 27-W be amended to extend its authorized territory to include

the territory requested by this application.

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determined that no show cause proceedings should be initiated against Florida Cities for serving outside of its certificated area. On December 14, 1994, Gulf Utility Company (Gulf) filed an objection to the notice of application for extension by Florida Cities. Gulf's protest pertained to Florida Cities' provision of water service to the Alico International Trade Center (Alico). On July 18, 1995, Florida Cities and Gulf filed their settlement agreement. On August 10, 1995 Alico filed an objection to the agreement between Florida Cities and Gulf. Subsequently, a new stipulation was entered into by Florida Cities, Gulf and Alico, which resolves both Gulf's and Alico's objection.

SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

As stated earlier, on August 10, 1995 Alico filed an objection to the agreement between Florida Cities and Gulf. The essence of Alico's objection was that Alico would have to pay higher service availability charges for Gulf's water service. On October 2, 1995, a copy of the settlement agreement between Florida Cities, Gulf and Alico was filed with this Commission. The settlement agreement is attached to this Order as Attachment A.

The highlights of the agreement include that Gulf shall connect and provide water service to 8782 Alico Road and 8774 Alico Road, Fort Myers, Florida, as soon as practicable, and in no event later than one year following the effective date of any Commission Order approving the stipulation. Florida Cities shall pay Gulf the appropriate service availability fees. Florida Cities shall continue to provide water service to Alico until Gulf provides water service to Alico. Alico shall remit \$70 to Gulf as the combined deposit for water service. Once connected, Alico shall remain the water service customer of Gulf, subject to Gulf's rules and regulations, including Gulf's service rates and service availability charges, as approved by this Commission or any successor regulatory authority. Florida Cities also agrees to smend its original application, thereby excluding Alico from its requested service area, following the effective date of this Order. Therefore, we find that Florida Cities' application with regard to Alico, is rendered moot by the parties' agreement.

Accordingly, we hereby approve the settlement agreement as a reasonable resolution to the parties' concerns. As stated earlier, the parties have agreed that Florida Cities will continue to temporarily serve the Alico customer until final service can be provided by Gulf. The agreement also states that this transition

NOTICE OF FURTHER PROCEEDINGS OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

The Florida Public Service Commission is required by Section 120.59(4). Florida Statutes, to notify parties of any administrative hearing or judicial review of Commission orders that is available under Sections 120.57 or 120.68, Florida Statutes, as well as the procedures and time limits that apply. This notice should not be construed to mean all requests for an administrative hearing or judicial review will be granted or result in the relief sought.

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- b) Once connected, said service locations shall remain the water service customers of Gulf, subject to Guli's rules and regulations, including Gulf's service rates and service swallability charges, as approved by the FFSC or any successor regulatory authority.
- c) Oelf's current rates and charges, to which said service locations are subject, are set forth in the attached letter.
- d) In 1982, FCMC collected \$1300 is service evailability charges for water service to \$782 Alico Road. Following the effective date of any FPSC Order approving this heended Settlement Agreement, Gulf and Alico respectively agree to withdray their objections to FCNC's Application for Extension of Service Area, once amended by FCNC as contemplated by paragraph 4 hereinahove, and shall make no further objections to the amended application so long as the same conforms to the intent, terms and conditions of this Amended Settlement Agreement as approved by the FPSC.
- FCWC shall continue to provide vater service to 8782 Alico Road and 8774 Alico Road, until Gulf connects Alico in accordance with paragraph 3 hereinahove. This interia service by FCWC shall be subject to FCMC's rules and regulations, as approved by the FFSC, or any successor regulatory authority.
- 7. Upon connection of 8782 Alico Road and 8774 Alico Road to Gulf's water system, Alico agrees to remit \$70 to Gulf as payment of the applicable combined deposit for water service to said two service locations. After connection to Gulf's water system, Alico agrees to be bound by Gulf's water service rate schedules and rules and regulations, as approved by the FREC.
