In March, 1998, Vanguard School of Lake Wales, Florida, submitted an informal complaint to the Commission regarding charges billed by MCI Telecommunications Corporation for T-1 line access and long distance service. Staff investigated the matter but was unable to effect a satisfactory resolution between the parties. An informal conference was requested by Vanguard pursuant to our Rule 25-22.032, F.A.C., and was conducted on September, 1998, in Lake Wales. No settlement of the complaint was forthcoming.

This complaint turns on disputes of fact, and issues of contract law. Staff recommends that this matter be referred to the Division of Administrative Hearings (DOAH) for further proceedings.
