


Dear Ms. Clark:



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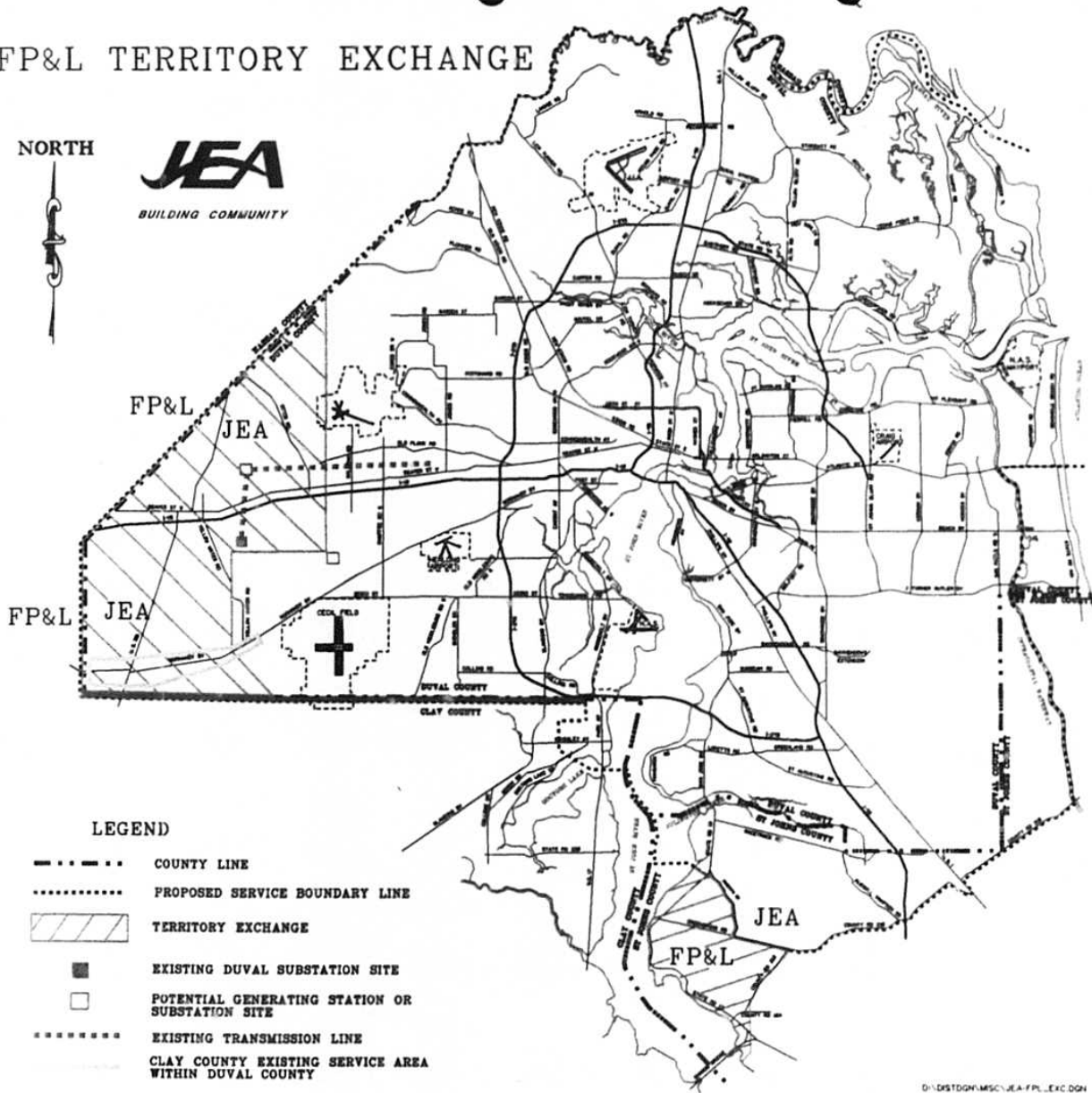



As the elected Councilperson for a portion of the area within the municipal limits of the Consolidated City of Jacksonville which will be transferred from the Florida Power and Light service area to the Jacksonville Electric Authority, I urge you to approve the territorial agreement presented to you by FPL and JEA. Knowing my District as I do, I feel that it is in the best interest of my constituents to be served by the JEA since as citizens of Jacksonville, they are part owners of that utility and deserve the benefits of service by it.

I am concerned that your staff has considered only the complaints of citizens of St. Johns County that would be transferred from JEA to FPL without giving due consideration to those persons in western Duval County who desire to be served by their own locally owned utility. The staff concerns with the financial impact on FPL are trivial to the point of immateriality when considered in the context of FPL's overall size and multi-billion dollar revenues. Also, that company's offer to maintain JEA rates for at least three years gives adequate assurances of rate equity for the affected St. John's County consumers.





The staff concerns with the financial impact on FPL are trivial to the point of immateriality when considered in the context of FPL's overall size and multi-billion dollar revenues. Also, that company's offer to maintain JEA rates for at least three years gives adequate assurances of rate equity for the affected St. John's County consumers.

I would like to express my opinions concerning the proposed swapping of service areas between Florida Power and Light and the Jacksonville Electric Authority. When I lived in South Florida, I was served by Florida Power and Light for a number of years. I have never know Florida Power and Light to be concerned about their customers. The thing that still sticks out most in my mind occurred during the first Arab Oil Embargo. Florida Power and Light ran public service announcements requesting the we cut back on electric consumption to conserve electricity. The public responded and made sufficient reductions in the use of electric power. Florida Power and Light responded not by thanking their customers for cutting back during a special time of need, but by asking for a rate increase because their profits were less than desired.

On two (possibly three) separate occasions Florida Power and Light had problems that caused them to lose their total power network. This resulted in power blackouts that lasted anywhere from two to six hours for hundreds of thousands of customers.

At this time, the two areas in question have about the same number of residential customers. However, the area that is to be taken over by FP&L is a very high growth area while the area to be taken over by the JEA is practically not growing at all. This means that FP&L is being given a much more lucrative area. So, even though the number of customer may be the same today, everyone knows that within ten years the proposed area to be given to FP&L may have twice as many customers. The trade is not equal.

Finally, the rates charged by Florida Power and Light are not competitive with the Jacksonville Electric Authority. The last home that we had in South Florida (1987) was 600 square feet smaller than my present house, and it also had a gas hot water heater. Yet my monthly electric bills were over 200 dollars a month, and that was over ten years ago. I'm sure they must have had rate hikes since that time. The highest bill that I have had up here has been 185 dollars, and that was during a heat wave when the daily temperatures were at or over 100 degrees much of the time. Our summer bills have averaged around 165 dollars a month. And this house is all electric, including an electric hot water heater.

I appreciate the offer of Florida Power and Light to hold our rates that the JEA level for three years if the trade is made. I have lived here for ten years. Three years passes quickly and the higher rates (twenty to fifty dollars a month) will be forever. Why would someone by my house if they can buy one a mile up the road with lower electric rates. Let the JEA purchase the territory they want from FP&L. Please do not switch our service to FP&L.

Thank you for your correspondence regarding the proposed territorial agreement between Florida Power and Light Company (FPL) and the Jacksonville Electric Authority (JEA). As a customer subject to transfer if the agreement is approved, your feedback is important to this Commission.

The Commission staff is currently reviewing the proposed agreement to determine its impact on each utility's distribution system and its customers and to determine if the agreement is in the public interest. Staff has requested additional information from each utility and will include that information in their analysis. Upon completion of their analysis, staff will prepare a recommendation to the Commissioners regarding whether or not the proposed territorial agreement should be approved. Until such time as the recommendation is filed with the Commission, staff is unable to comment either for or against the proposed agreement and transfer of customers.

Staff expects to file their recommendation with the Commission on September 10, 1998. The Commissioners are expected to vote on this matter at the September 22, 1998 Agenda Conference. As a customer affected by the proposed territorial agreement, you may address the Commissioners on this matter when it is taken up for discussion on that date.

In your correspondence, you requested that the Commission move its conference for the discussion and vote on the proposed territorial agreement to Jacksonville or St. Johns County. The Commission's decision regarding approval of this agreement is one of approximately 40 to 50 issues to be addressed at the September 22, 1998 Agenda Conference. At this conference, the Commission will consider issues affecting electric, gas, telecommunication, water and wastewater utilities and their ratepayers throughout the state. It is not possible for the Commissioners and Commission staff to travel to all 40 or 50 locations that are affected by each decision. In fairness



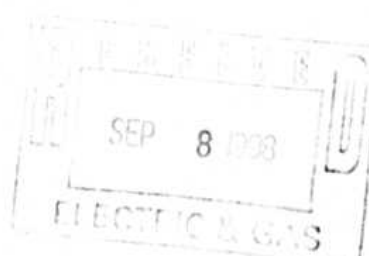



Pursuant to my telephone conversation with your office of earlier this afternoon, this letter shall serve as my request to be added to your Docket Mailing List for the above referenced.

I am currently a resident in the affected area and am very concerned about this proposed change. If this change is approved, we stand to loose all the way around. We have people in our area who have been previous FP&L customers. By their testimonies, FP&L can take up to as much as 24 hours to restore electric services which are brought down by storms, power surges or other means. These are people who have experienced this and have been very happy with their change to JEA. Right now, JEA restores our services within an hour or so, and often, more quickly than that. The lengthy restoration of services could cost us more than just the additional monthly increase if we have to replace spoiled food from our refrigerators.

In addition to losing the quality services JEA provides, we will have an increase to our monthly bill anywhere from \$60 - \$360 (and more to some residents with larger homes) per year. This is a rural community with many elderly people on fixed incomes and many single parent families. Many do not have the means to pay additional money for FP&L's services. And, by adding to the electric bill, that means money has to be taken from somewhere else, like clothes, shoes or food.

In closing, my family will be very much affected by this exchange and I want to do all I can to make the PSC aware that I oppose this exchange and plead to them to look deeper than the utility company's desire to make a mutually beneficial exchange of territory between themselves. The way we see this, it is definitely not beneficial to the people of this community who have to live with the decision the PSC make.

Once again, I respectfully request that my name be placed on the mailing list so I can be apprised of what is happening. Thank you for your professional courtesy.

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
