Tampa Electric Company ("Tampa Electric" or "the company"), hereby submits its Statement of the Issues and Positions to be taken up at the hearing scheduled to commence on February 10, 1999 in the above docket.

**CONSERVATION COST RECOVERY**

**Issue No. 1:** What was the actual true-up amount for the October 1997 - March 1998 period for Tampa Electric?

**Tampa Electric's Position:** An overrecovery of \$975,858, including interest. (Witness: Bryant)

**Issue No. 2:** What is the appropriate projected end of period total net true-up amount for Tampa Electric for the period April 1998 - March 1999?

**Tampa Electric's Position:** An overrecovery of \$2,262,323, including interest. (Witness: Bryant)

**Issue No. 3:** What are the appropriate conservation cost recovery factors to be applied by Tampa Electric during the period April 1999 through December 1999?

**Tampa Electric's Position:** 0.017 cents per KWH for Interruptible, 0.132 cents per KWH for Residential, 0.118 cents per KWH for General Service Non-Demand and Temporary Service, 0.104 cents per KWH for General Service Demand and Electric Vehicle - Experimental -
