1. On December 23, 1998, the Florida Public Service Commission requested in its First Expedited Request for Production of Documents, all associated work papers and source documents relating to Exhibit DDC-2 to D. Daonne Caldwell's Direct Testimony. BellSouth is producing the requested information concurrently with this Request for Confidential Classification of that information.

2. BellSouth has appended to this Request for Confidential Classification as Attachment A an identification of the location of the specific information for which confidential classification is requested.

3. BellSouth has appended to this Request as Attachment B a redacted paper copy of the information for which confidential classification is requested.

4. BellSouth has appended to this Request as Attachment C a highlighted paper copy of the information for which confidential classification is requested.

5. The subject information is related to prices that BellSouth has negotiated with specific vendors. Specifically, the subject information entails the prices and/or fees, that BellSouth has negotiated with contracted vendors to provide certain services for BellSouth relating to OSS electronic interfaces. If the negotiated prices and/or fees that BellSouth receives were publicly disclosed, this disclosure would impair BellSouth's ability to obtain favorable discounts in the future. Accordingly, this information is entitled to confidential classification pursuant to Fla. Stat. § 164.183(3)(d).

6. BellSouth has treated and intends to continue to treat the information for which confidential classification is sought as private, and this information has not been generally disclosed.

7. The original of this Request has been filed with the Division of Records and Reporting, and a copy has been served on the Division requesting the information.

WHEREFORE, based on the foregoing, BellSouth moves the Commission to enter an order declaring the information described above to be confidential information that is not subject to public disclosure.
