**D. STATEMENT OF BASIC POSITION**

**Tampa Electric's Statement of Basic Position:**

The Commission should determine that Tampa Electric has properly calculated its conservation cost recovery true-up and projections and that the appropriate conservation cost recovery factor to be applied by Tampa Electric during the period April 1, 1999 through December 31, 1999 is 0.017 cents per KWH for Interruptible, 0.132 cents per KWH for Residential, 0.118 cents per KWH for General Service Non-Demand and Temporary Service, 0.104 cents per KWH for General Service Demand and Electric Vehicle – Experimental – Secondary, 0.103 cents per KWH for General Service Demand and Electric Vehicle – Experimental – Primary, 0.98 cents per KWH for General Service Large Demand and Firm Standby – Secondary, 0.097 cents per KWH for General Service Large Demand and Firm Standby – Primary, 0.96 cents per KWH for General Service Large Demand and Firm Standby – Subtransmission, and 0.059 cents per KWH for Lighting.

**E. STATEMENT OF ISSUES AND POSITIONS**

**Generic Conservation Cost Recovery Issues**

**ISSUE 1:** What is the final end-of-the-period true-up amounts for the period October 1, 1997 through March 31, 1998?

**TECO:** An overrecovery of \$975,858, including interest. (Bryant)

**ISSUE 2:** What are the appropriate conservation cost recovery factors for the period April 1999 through December 1999?

**TECO:** 0.017 cents per KWH for Interruptible  
0.132 cents per KWH for Residential  
0.118 cents per KWH for General Service Non-Demand and Temporary Service  
0.104 cents per KWH for General Service Demand and Electric Vehicle – Experimental – Secondary

- 0.103 cents per KWH for General Service Demand and Electric Vehicle – Experimental – Primary
- 0.098 cents per KWH for General Service Large Demand and Firm Standby – Secondary
- 0.097 cents per KWH for General Service Large Demand and Firm Standby – Primary
- 0.096 cents per KWH for General Service Large Demand and Firm Standby – Subtransmission
- 0.059 cents per KWH for Lighting (Bryant)


