PURSUANT TO RULE 25-22.029(4) OF THE FLORIDA ADMINISTRATIVE CODE, THE UNDERSIGNED HEREBY PETITION THE FLORIDA PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION TO SCHEDULE A FORMAL PROCEEDING WITH REGARD TO THE ABOVE REFERENCED UTILITY IN AN EFFORT TO ALLOW AFFECTED CUSTOMERS TO BE HEARD. THE AFFECTED CUSTOMERS, WHOSE NAMES AND ADDRESSES APPEAR BELOW, REQUEST A HEARING WITHIN SIXTY (60) DAYS AND STATE THE FOLLOWING:

- 1. THE NAME AND ADDRESS OF THE APPLICANT IS WILLIAM WERNER, D/B/A SHANGRI LA BY THE LAKE UTILITIES, INC., P.O. BOX 345, SPARTA, MI 49345.
- 2. AFFECTED CUSTOMERS DID NOT RECEIVE NOTICE THAT THE APPLICANT INTENDED TO LICENSE THE UTILITY AND CHARGE ITS CUSTOMERS FOR WATER AND SEWER AND THE APPLICANT IS IN VIOLATION OF FLORIDA ADMINISTRATIVE CODE, RULE 25-30.030, AND IS THEREFORE NOT ENTITLED TO THE BENEFITS AND MONETARY PROFITS TO BE GAINED FROM SUCH LICENSE.
- 3. THE BASE RATE ESTABLISHED IS UNFAIR AND ERRONEOUS AS IT WAS NOT BASED ON COMPETENT SUBSTANTIAL EVIDENCE OR ACCURATE COST RECORDS BUT MERELY ON ASSERTIONS MADE BY THE APPLICANT WHICH HAVE NO BEARING ON FACT.
- 4. THERE IS NO SEASONAL RATE ESTABLISHED FOR PART-TIME RESIDENTS, WHICH IS UNJUST AND UNFAIR IN THAT SUCH NON-USERS ARE REQUIRED TO PAY THE MINIMUM \$23.91 PER MONTH EVEN WHEN THE WATER AND SEWER IS SHUT OFF.
- 5. THE APPLICANT ASSERTS HIS OPERATING EXPENSES AMOUNT TO \$14.13 PER MONTH PER HOME, WHICH CONTRADICTS THE CALCULATIONS OF THE PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION AT \$43.48 PER MONTH. THE TRUE OPERATING EXPENSES SHOULD BE ESTABLISHED IN ORDER TO SET A FAIR AND EQUITABLE BASE RATE CHARGE TO CUSTOMERS.
- 6. THE AFFECTED CUSTOMERS ARE ENTITLED TO BE HEARD IN AN EFFORT TO REACH A FAIR AND EQUITABLE FACILITY CHARGE. THE DOCUMENTS AVAILABLE TO THE UNDERSIGNED INDICATE THE UTILITY WILL BE EARNING A MINIMUM PROFIT OF 10.82% BUT CHARGING ITS CUSTOMERS 350% MORE THAN ITS COSTS, WHICH IS AN UNFAIR PERCENTAGE OF RETURN FOR A PUBLIC SERVICE MONOPOLY.
- 7. THE PETITIONERS HAVE A SUBSTANTIAL INTEREST AS A RESULT OF THE DETERMINATION ISSUED BY THE PSC WITH REGARD TO THE UILITY IN THAT EGREGIOUS AND UNFAIR CHARGES ARE BEING MADE TO PETITIONERS FOR THE COST OF WATER AND SEWER, WHICH COSTS WERE CALCULATED AND BASED ON INACCURATE ESTIMATES PROVIDED BY THE APPLICANT.

- 8. THE OPERATION OF THE UTILITY IS SERIOUSLY FLAWED IN THAT THE WATER/SEWER IS FREQUENTLY OUT OF SERVICE; THE WATER PRESSURE IS UNREASONABLY LOW, IRREGULAR, AND INEFFICIENT FOR NORMAL USE; THE SEWER LINES WERE NOT PLANNED AND/OR LAID BY A QUALIFIED ENGINEER AND DUE TO IMPROPER INSTALLATION OF SEWER LINES THERE ARE FREQUENT BACK-UPS AND SEWAGE SEEPING INTO LAWNS; THE LAKE COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH HAS HAD NUMEROUS COMPLAINTS ABOUT SEWAGE PROBLEMS WITH THIS UTILITY; THERE IS LACK OF PROFESSIONAL MANAGEMENT; THE ELECTRICAL SERVICE AT THE FACILITY, INCLUDING BREAKERS, ARE INADEQUATE AND WERE NOT INSTALLED BY A PROFESSIONAL ELECTRICIAN; AND THE RATES CHARGED ARE EGREGIOUS.
- 9. THE UTILITY IS UNFAIRLY AND DISCRIMINATORILY CHARGING CUSTOMERS IN THAT SOME HOMEOWNERS WITHIN THE MOBILE HOME PARK OWNED BY THE UTILITY OWNER HAVE HAD METERS INSTALLED BY THE UTILITY, SOME DO NOT HAVE METERS, SOME HOMEOWNERS ARE BEING BILLED FOR WATER AND SEWER AS OF JANUARY 1, 1999 AND SOME ARE NOT BEING BILLED FOR WATER AND SEWER.

WHEREFORE, THE UNDERSIGNED RESPECTFULLY PETITION THE COMMISSION TO:

- A. SCHEDULE A PROMPT AND TIMELY HEARING BEFORE THE PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION WITH REGARD TO THE LICENSING AND SCHEDULE OF RATES OF SHANGRI LABY THE LAKE UTILITIES, INC.; AND
 - B. ISSUE A RATE RELIEF TO ALL AFFECTED CUSTOMERS; AND
- C. ESTABLISH FAIR AND EQUITABLE RELIEF TO SEASONAL CUSTOMERS WHO SHUT-OFF WATER AND SEWER WHEN NOT IN RESIDENCE AND TO DISCONTINUE CHARGES FOR SUCH SEASONAL USERS: AND
- D. ISSUE AN INJUNCTION AGAINST THE UTILITY TO CEASE AND DESIST FROM CHARGING THE PETITIONERS FOR WATER AND SEWER, RETROACTIVE TO JANUARY 1, 1999, UNTIL THIS PETITION CAN BE HEARD AND EQUITABLE RELIEF PROVIDED; AND
- E. REVOKE, NULLIFY AND/OR POSTPONE THE LICENSE OF SHANGRI LA BY THE LAKE UTILITIES, INC. UNTIL A SATISFACTORY RESOLUTION IS REACHED BETWEEN ALL CONCERNED PARTIES REGARDING ALL ISSUES IN DISPUTE.

Dear Dirctor and Commissioners:

Enclosed please find a Petition filed by and on behalf of 5 customers were were adversely affected by the Commission's decision relating to Shangri La by the Lake Utilities, Inc. We are requesting, among other pleas, that a formal hearing be held so that affected customers can be heard. No notice was ever given to the affected customers of the application that was filed by the utility. In reading the petition, you will note there are several issues which should be addressed by the Public Service Commission.

Due to the utility's failure to notify affected customers of its application for license and establishment of fees, the adversely affected customers were not able to timely file a motion for reconsideration by the Director and are hereby doing so.

We hope it will not be necessary to seek legal counsel and expend funds for legal fees to take this matter to the First District Court of Appeals as all petitioners are senior citizens on limited incomes and unable to afford such an expense. It is through no fault of the customers that a petition could not be filed timely. It is anticipated you will consider our request fairly in light of the utility owner's calculated and deliberate failure to notify anyone of his intent.

We are hopeful you will honor this petition and offer us some redress for the egregious situation that exists. The addresses of all petitioners are noted on the petition, all of whom are of Leesburg, Florida 34788 and residents of the mobile home park owned by the utility owner.
