Issue 1: Should the Commission propose the amendments to Rule 25-6.049, Florida Administrative Code, as shown in the attachment to staff's January 19, 1999 memorandum?

Recommendation: Yes. Staff's proposed rule amendment reflects the changes it believes are appropriate to clarify the provisions of Rule 25-6.049, Florida Administrative Code, regarding the requirements for individual metering of buildings constructed before 1981.
