RE: DOCKET NO. 981322-TC - Cancellation by Florida Public Service Commission of Pay Telephone Certificate No. 4936 issued to Ashok Mahavir d/b/a Mahavir Communications for violation of Rule 25-4.0161, F.A.C., Regulatory Assessment Fees; Telecommunications Companies.

Issue 1: Should the Commission accept the settlement offer proposed by Mahavir Communications to resolve the apparent violations of Rule 25-4.0161, Florida Administrative Code, Regulatory Assessment Fees; Telecommunications Companies?

Recommendation: Yes. The Commission should accept Mahavir Communications' settlement offer. Any contribution should be paid by the company within five business days from the effective date of the Commission order. The Commission should forward the contribution to the Office of the Comptroller for deposit in the State General Revenue Fund pursuant to Section 364.285(1), Florida Statutes.
