

COMES NOW, BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc., ("BellSouth"), pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, and files its Motion for Extension of Duration of Orders Granting Confidential Classification, and states as grounds in support thereof the following:

1. On October 25, 1996, BellSouth filed a Request for Confidential Classification and Motion for Permanent Protective Order for the Cost Studies on Unbundled Loop Information (TELRIC) filed with the Commission on October 4, 1996. The Commission assigned Document No. 11389-96.

2. On October 28, 1996, BellSouth also filed a Request for Confidential Classification and Motion for Permanent Protective Order for vendor specific prices and revenue and cost data responsive to Staff's Second Request for Production of Documents filed on October 7, 1996. The Commission assigned Document No. 11447-96.

3. By Orders issued August 11, 1997, the Florida Public Service Commission ("Commission") granted BellSouth's Request for Confidential Classification and Motion for Protective Order of information contained in the Cost Studies on Unbundled Loop Information (Order No. PSC-97-0951-CFO-TL) and the vendor specific prices and revenue and cost data (Order No. PSC-97-0956-CFO-TL).

4. Under the provisions of Rule 25-22.006(9), an order granting confidential classification is effective for 18 months. Therefore, the confidential classification granted in these Orders expires on February 11, 1999.

5. The information requested remains in the possession of Staff.


6. The reasons BellSouth asserted in support of confidential treatment in its original motion continue to pertain. Specifically, there is still a need to protect cost and vendor specific information.

7. For the reasons set forth above, and in the original Requests for Confidential Classification and Motion for Permanent Protective Order filed on October 25, 1996 and October 28, 1996, BellSouth hereby requests that this Commission enter Orders extending the period of confidential classification for an additional 18 months, or for any longer period of time that the documents remain within the possession of Staff, for each of these Requests.


WHEREFORE, for the reasons set forth above, BellSouth respectfully requests the entry of Orders extending the period of confidential classification as described above.

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
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
