**RE:** Docket No. 981615-TC - Cancellation by Florida Public Service Commission of PATS Certificate No. 5520 issued to Robert Michael Alley, for violation of Rule 25-4.0161, F.A.C., Regulatory Assessment Fees; Telecommunications Companies

Order No. PSC-99-0229-FOF-TC was issued February 9, 1999, and ordered the company to pay a \$500 fine plus past due regulatory assessment fees, along with statutory penalty and interest charges. The company had until March 2, 1999 to respond to the Order. On March 15, 1999, I received the attached letter dated February 16, 1999, forwarded to me by the Division of Administration, which stated that the company had enclosed payment of the past due amount and requested that his certificate not be canceled. Mr. Alley's letter had a hand-written note dated March 11, which advised that the 2/16 letter had been returned by the Post Office. Since staff needs to take this back to Agenda, please reopen the docket and use the attached from the company as its response to the Order.

To Whom it may concern:

It is with the utmost of humility and embarrassment that I write this letter to you today. The attached documents reflect a proposed cancellation by the Florida Public Service Commission of my Pay Telephone Certificate #5520. The purpose of my writing today is to briefly explain why it happened, to submit all current and past documentation and assessments due, and to humbly ask for my license not to be canceled.

1. 12/5-12/31/97 Regulatory Assessment Fee- I received my license in December 1997 but did not place phones at locations until 1998. Being new to the business, I did not realize that a \$50 minimum fee had to be paid regardless of having \$0 revenues to report. Attached please find the 1997 Assessment Fee Return with a check for \$69.50 (\$50 plus penalty and interest).
2. 1998 Regulatory Assessment Form- I do not recall ever getting it. Having never filled one out before, it was not something I was looking for either. The reality is that I should have know however and followed up to get a copy. I did not. I have enclosed a copy of 1997's with 1998's information on it. I have also attached a separate check for \$49.34 which covers the assessment plus interest and late payment.

It was never my intention to defraud the Florida Public Service Commission or the State of Florida out of any assessments. My actions (or lack of) were instead a product of being a first time small business owner who continues to learn from his painful mistakes. I hold no one responsible for these issues but myself. I am accountable for my mistakes, but is my hope that you let me learn from this and let me continue to provide payphone service to the Central Florida area. Please let me know what else I can do or provide.
