
MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

COMES NOW COLORADO RIVER COMMUNICATIONS CORP., ("CRC") through undersigned counsel respectfully requests an extension of an additional three (3) weeks of time in which to respond to the Order to Show Cause which was issued by the Florida Public Service Commission ("Commission") on February 24, 1999.

CRC is presently in the process of negotiating a proposed settlement with the Staff of the Commission. A sufficient amount of time no longer remains in which to complete these negotiations which necessitates this request for extension.

If a settlement cannot be reached or if the Commission does not approve of the negotiated settlement within this three (3) week period, CRC request that it be granted a ten (10) day time period from the date settlement negotiations end or from the date the Commission rejects the proposed settlement in which to respond to the Order.
