CASE BACKGROUND

On October 10, 1995, the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County adopted Resolution No. R-95-109, pursuant to Section 367.171, Florida Statutes, declaring that, as of October 10, 1995, the water and wastewater utilities in that County shall become subject to the provision of the Water and Wastewater Regulatory Chapter 367, Florida Statutes. The resolution was acknowledged by this Commission on November 9, 1995, by Order No. PSC-95-1393-FOF-WS.

This docket was opened in order to acknowledge Manatee County's resolution, to ensure that all jurisdictional entities filed applications for certificates or exemptions and to process certain exemption applications. Subsequent to the time this docker was opened, Section 367.022, Florida Statutes, became self-Utilities that meet the requirements of Section executing. 367.022, Florida Statutes, no longer have to apply for exemption
