MOTION TO INTERVENE

COMES NOW Sarasota County, Florida, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, pursuant to Rule 25-22.039, Florida Administrative Code, and requests this Commission to grant intervenor status to Sarasota County in the above-referenced proceeding. In support of this motion, movant states as follows:

1. The proposed telephone exchange boundary between Sarasota County and Charlotte County bifurcates the community of Englewood which is located in both counties.
2. Sarasota County government is investing hundreds of thousands of dollars in the community of Englewood to redevelop and revitalize the downtown area for all the citizens of Englewood.
3. Imposing two different area codes in a community the size of Englewood would be unnecessarily cumbersome and confusing to the citizens of Englewood.
4. Dividing the community into two different area codes would necessitate ten-digit dialing for some residents to call local schools, medical facilities and commercial businesses.

THEREFORE, for the reasons above stated, Sarasota County, Florida, through its undersigned counsel, respectfully requests that the Commission grant full-party intervenor status to Sarasota County, Florida.
