CHARLOTTE COUNTY, FLORIDA, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, pursuant to Rule 25-22.039, Florida Administrative Code, hereby requests the Florida Public Service Commission to grant intervenor status to Charlotte County in the above-referenced proceeding, and in support thereof states that:

1. Charlotte County is currently located within the 941 area code, which was changed from 813 only three (3) years ago at great expense to citizens, local businesses, and government agencies.
2. A change or split in the County's area code would directly impact Charlotte County citizens, commercial businesses, schools, hospitals, and governmental offices, both financially and operationally.
3. Charlotte County and other groups such as the Charlotte County Tourist Development Council and Charlotte County Chamber of Commerce have spent significant amounts of money to create a sense of community and bring together all geographic areas of the County, including and describing the entire community.
4. The Board of County Commissioners of Charlotte County is charged with protecting the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Charlotte County, Florida, and as such has a substantial interest in the above-referenced proceeding.

THEREFORE, for the reasons above stated, Charlotte County, Florida, through its undersigned counsel, respectfully requests the Commission to grant full-party intervenor status to Charlotte County, Florida.
