MOTION TO INTERVENE

CHARLOTTE COUNTY, FLORIDA, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, pursuant to Rule 25-22.039, Florida Administrative Code, hereby requests the Florida Public Service Commission to grant intervenor status to Charlotte County in the above-referenced proceeding, and in support thereof states that:

- 1. Charlotte County is currently located within the 941 area code, which was changed from 813 only three (3) years ago at great expense to citizens, local businesses, and government agencies.
- 2. A change or split in the County's area code would directly impact Charlotte County citizens, commercial businesses, schools, hospitals, and governmental offices, both financially and operationally.
- Charlotte County and other groups such as the Charlotte County Tourist Development Council and Charlotte County Chamber of Commerce have spent significant amounts of money to create a sense of community and bring together all geographic areas of the County, including and describing the entire community.
- 4. The Board of County Commissioners of Charlotte County is charged with protecting the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Charlotte County, Florida, and as such has a substantial interest in the above-referenced proceeding.

THEREFORE, for the reasons above stated, Charlotte County, Florida, through its undersigned counsel, respectfully requests the Commission to grant full-party intervenor status to Charlotte County, Florida.
