JOHN CHARLES HEEKIN objects to the request for representation by qualified representative served on him by Patrick M. Bryan and says:

1. R. Wade Litchfield represented himself to the undersigned as an attorney for FPL previously.
2. If R. Wade Litchfield in fact is not admitted to practice before the courts of the State of Florida, that statement was inaccurate.
3. Florida Power & Light Company can well afford to hire a member of The Florida Bar to represent it, and should be required to do so.
4. In the alternative, the undersigned should be authorized to hire a consultant to represent him in lieu of having an attorney do so. That is plainly silly. Corporations are required to be represented by counsel and individuals must be represented either by members of The Florida Bar or by themselves.
