CHARLOTTE COUNTY'S PREHEARING STATEMENT

(a) <u>Witnesses</u>

- Mac V. Horton, Chairman, Charlotte County Board of County Commissioners. The impact of changing part or all of Charlotte County's area code just three years after the last area code change, the resulting expense and confusion to the County's citizens and businesses, and preference for splitting the 941 area code into more than two sectors to lengthen area code exhaust time.
- Wayne Sallade, Charlotte County Director of Emergency Management. The impact of two different area codes in Charlotte County on the County's Emergency Management plan, including delays in public notice and evacuation, increased costs and manpower; recommendation to now split 941 area code into more than just two sectors to lengthen area code exhaust time.
- Cheryl Lauzon, Charlotte County Director of Tourist Development. Charlotte County's several diverse geographic and population areas and current major marketing effort to unify the public's perception of Charlotte County as one physical travel destination; request to delay the expense of changing area codes as long as possible.
- 4. Bill Wishard, President, Charlotte County Chamber of Commerce, and Major Accounts Manager, Florida Power Corp.

How splitting the area code within Charlotte County would alter the County's sense of community, how using a river or road as an artificial boundary line would harm the community, and preference for adding more area codes now rather than changing them so often.

(b) <u>Exhibits</u> None

(c) <u>Basic Position</u>

The proposed split of the 941 area code will be extremely detrimental to the citizens, businesses, and government of Charlotte County. A preferred alternative is to split the 941 area code service area into more than two sectors, thereby delaying further area code splits for a longer period of time. If Charlotte County must be split, moving the southern dividing line for the new 941 sector to the southern area of Charlotte County, where there is less development, would be much preferred.

- (d) <u>Questions of Fact at Issue</u>
 - 1. The expense and harm of frequent area code changes to Charlotte County citizens, businesses, and government; the expense and harm are too great; all witnesses.
 - 2. Whether the Proposed Numbering Plan Relief for the 941 Area Code best resolves the exhaustion of 941 area code numbers; the proposed plan is only a temporary measure and does not address the problem long term; all County witnesses.
- (e) <u>Questions of Law at Issue</u>
 - If the PSC approves the Proposed Numbering Plan Relief for the 941 Area Code, what effect would such decision have on PSC Docket No. 990184-TL "Investigation into boundary issues in South Sarasota and North Charlotte Counties (Englewood Area)"? None, since they are two separate dockets.
 - 2. Could a later PSC decision in Docket No. 990184-TL affect the instant case, thereby necessitating further area code service area revisions? It is possible.
 - 3. What if the PSC approves a different revised plan of relief for the 941 area code, that allows Charlotte and Sarasota Counties to share the same area code? Docket No. 990184-TL would then become moot and could be closed.
- (f) Policy Questions at Issue
 - 1. What factors should determine how the exhaustion of numbers in the 941 area code service area is addressed? A combination of technical, financial, governmental, demographic, geographic, and political factors. All County witnesses.
 - 2. Should local governments, citizens and businesses in the affected areas be given a voice in the process? Yes. All County witnesses.

- 3. Should the process be technical, political, or a combination thereof? A combination thereof. All County witnesses.
- (g) <u>Stipulated Issues</u> None that Charlotte County is aware of.
- (h) <u>Pending Motions or Other Matters</u>
 - 1. Charlotte County's Motion to Intervene dated March 18, 1999.
 - 2. Charlotte County's Motion for Extension of Time dated March 18, 1999.
 - 3. Charlotte and Sarasota Counties' Joint Motion Joining Sprint and GTE's Joint Motion to Consolidate, dated March 23, 1999.
- (i) <u>Requirements that cannot be complied with, and reasons therefore</u>.
 - Controlling dates of March 18, 1999, for filing Prefiled Direct Testimony because Charlotte County filed its Motion to Intervene on March 19, 1999, and just received a copy of the "Order Establishing Procedure" by FAX from the PSC on March 23, 1999.
