
Attached is a copy of the application of Morningside Utilities, Inc. for an amendment of certificate to provide water service in Osceola county. Pursuant to the Memorandum of Understanding between the Department of Community Affairs (DCA) and the Public Service Commission (PSC), the DCA has agreed to provide input on need for service and comprehensive plan consistency on applications for amendments or original certificates filed with the PSC.

The filing of Lake Groves Utilities, Inc. is the twenty-fourth filing to receive this treatment. The PSC staff requests that a response from the DCA be received by April 30, 1999. If this application is protested within the next 30 days, the docket will be set for hearing. Should this happen, the DCA will be updated by the PSC staff assigned to the case.
