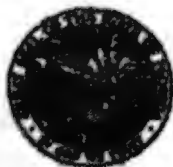

Dear Ms. Kuharske:

This correspondence is a follow-up to our conversation on March 24, 1999. I have verified that Southwest Pay Telephone Corporation is a certificated pay telephone service provider in Florida.

For your information, the local exchange service provided to all pay telephones you sold to Southwest should be billed to Southwest, not P.F. Chang's. When your certificate is cancelled, all serving local exchange companies in Florida will cancel pay telephone service accounts in P.F. Chang's name. It is your belief that one pay telephone may still be registered with the local exchange company under the name P.F. Chang's. Southwest should ensure that local exchange companies are billing Southwest for pay telephones involved in the transaction.

Also, the pay telephone placards should all be changed to show Southwest as the provider, not P.F. Chang's. Commission employees frequently inspect pay telephones throughout Florida and the instruments should correctly display the name of the certificate holder.

The last matter involves regulatory assessment fees. Because its pay telephone certificate was active for 1998 and remains active until cancellation by the Commission, P.F. Chang's is responsible for payment of regulatory assessment fees. In accordance with your request to immediately make payment, I have verified with the Division of Administration that P.F. Chang's owes \$112.00 in regulatory assessment fees, penalty, and interest. Details of the fees are provided in the following table:


