Issue 2: Should the Commission grant the request for voluntary cancellation submitted by BCI?

Recommendation: No.

Issue 3: Should the Commission impose a \$500 fine or cancel the interexchange telecommunications certificate of BCI for apparent violation of Rule 25-4.0161, Florida Administrative Code, Regulatory Assessment Fees, effective January 26, 1999?

Recommendation: Yes. The Commission should impose a \$500 fine or cancel BCI's certificate effective January 26, 1999, if the fine and the regulatory assessment fees, including statutory penalties and interest, are not received by the Commission within 5 business days after the conclusion of the 21-day protest period. The fine should be paid to the Florida Public Service Commission and forwarded to the Office of the Comptroller for deposit in the State General Revenue Fund pursuant to Section 364.285(1), Florida Statutes. If the Commission's Order is not protested and the fines and the regulatory assessment fees, including statutory penalties and interest, are not received, it should be forwarded to the Comptroller's Office for further collection and the certificate should be canceled.
