Thank you for the great effort you are putting forth for the citizens of Florida. However, ten digit dialing makes Floridians the odd ones outside the standard for all telephones in the United States. Ten digit dialing has placed an undue burden on Central Floridians. I urge you to reverse your decision for ten digit dialing in Central Florida. Instead, please work to standarize dialing throughout the United States . If the national standard must be ten diget dialing, that's fine. But, Central Florida should not be made the odd one until a national standard has been agreed.
