
This letter will confirm our recent discussion concerning the above-referenced water system. Levy County is hereby requesting a waiver of the rule requiring the filing of annual reports and the past due RAF's.

As you know this system was abandoned for the second time. Levy County is the resent receiver and there are no funds to pay the past due RAF's. Substantial work and money has been invested by Levy County just to make the system operable.

There are no records available to prepare and file the annual reports. Diligent effort was made to obtain the records but we were unsuccessful. Therefore, it seems clear this situation meets the conditions for waiver under Section 120.542(2), Florida Statutes.
