Dear Customer:

On May 18, 1998, United Water Florida Inc. ("United Water Florida") filed an application with the Florida Public Service Commission ("Commission") for an increase in its water and wastewater rates in Duval, Nassau and St. Johns Counties, Florida. The rate increases are primarily due to capital investments that are being required to meet more stringent environmental regulations, rehabilitation of United Water Florida's water distribution and wastewater collection systems, and major enhancements to United Water Florida's water and wastewater treatment processes. The Staff of the Commission conducted customer meetings on September 9, 10, and 11, 1998. On March 12, 1999, the Commission issued a Notice of Proposed Agency Action Approving Increased Water and Wastewater Rates and Charges ("PAA Order").

A petition for a formal hearing on the PAA Order was filed with the Commission by the Office of Public Counsel ("OPC"). On May 4, 1999, the Commission adopted a Stipulation between OPC and United Water Florida and Withdrawal of Protest by OPC and established approved rates. A schedule showing United Water Florida's rates prior to the rate case (<u>i.e.</u>, Present Rates), United Water Florida's requested rates, and the Commission's approved rates is set forth on the reverse side of this notice. The approved rates are effective for service rendered on or after May \_\_\_\_, 1999.

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On May 18, 1998, United Water Florida Inc. ("United Water Florida") filed an application with the Florida Public Service Commission ("Commission") for an increase in its water and wastewater rates in Duval, Nassau and St. Johns Counties, Florida. The rate increases are primarily due to capital investments that are being required to meet more stringent environmental regulations, rehabilitation of United Water Florida's water distribution and wastewater collection systems, and major enhancements to United Water Florida's water and wastewater treatment processes. The Staff of the Commission conducted customer meetings on September 9, 10, and 11, 1998. On March 12, 1999, the Commission issued a Notice of Proposed Agency Action Approving Increased Water and Wastewater Rates and Charges ("PAA Order").

In the PAA Order, the Commission ordered that Guaranteed Revenue Charges and Allowance for Funds Prudently Invested ("AFPI") charges be collected from customers to be connected to United Water Florida's Blacks Ford Wastewater Treatment Plant. A petition for a formal hearing on the PAA Order was filed with the Commission by the Office of Public Counsel ("OPC"). On May 4, 1999, the Commission adopted a Stipulation between OPC and United Water Florida and Withdrawal of Protest by OPC and established Approved Rates. The AFPI Charges were not changed. The Guaranteed Revenue Charges are based on base facility charges and, accordingly, the Guaranteed Revenue Charge was reduced by the adoption of the Stipulation. The charges are effective on and after May \_\_\_\_, 1999. A schedule of the Guaranteed Revenue Charges and AFPI charges is set forth on the reverse side of this Notice.
