PETITION FOR CLARIFICATION OF THE FINAL ORDER APPROVING NUMBERING PLAN AREA RELIEF FOR THE 941 AREA CODE

The North American Numbering Plan Administrator Lockheed Martin IMS ("NANPA"), in its role as the neutral third party NPA Relief Planner for Florida under the North American Numbering Plan, hereby petitions the Florida Public Service Commission to clarify its Final Order Approving Numbering Plan Area Relief for the 941 Area Code, issued May 25, 1999 ("Final Order") in the above-captioned proceeding.¹ The Final Order established a single geographic split, referred to as

Alternative #16, as the relief plan for the 941 area code and established a schedule for the implementation of Alternative #16.² Additionally, the Final Order stated that. "based on testimony provided by the NANPA witness, the projected exhaust dates for the 941 and the new area code under Alternative #16 . . . are 3.5 and 8.9 years, respectively." This sentence indicates that the NANPA witness, Pamela Kenworthy, calculated and testified as to the projected lives of the 941 and new area codes under Alternative #16. However, the NANPA witness could not have provided testimony regarding Alternative #16 because at the time that NANPA's witness filed direct testimony⁴ and testified at the technical hearing held in Sarasota on April 8, 1999, the only two times NANPA's witness provided testimony in this proceeding. Alternative #16 did not exist.⁵ In response to inquiry from undersigned counsel for NANPA, a member of the Commission staff indicated that the sentence at issue was likely not intended to attribute the actual calculation of the projected lives of Alternative #16 directly to the testimony of NANPA's witness, but merely to indicate that the calculations, developed by Commission staff, were merely based on testimony provided by NANPA's witness. In any event, NANPA respectfully requests that the
