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

# PRICE LIST FORMAT SHEETS

- A. Sheet Numbering Sheet numbers appear in the upper right corner of the page. Sheets are numbered sequentially. However, new sheets are occasionally added to the price list. When a new sheet is added between sheets already in effect, a decimal is added. For example, a new sheet added between sheets 14 and 15 would be 14.1.
- B. Sheet Revision Numbers Revision numbers also appear in the upper right corner of each page. These numbers are used to determine the most current sheet version on file with the FPSC. For example, the 4th revised sheet 14 cancels the 3rd revised sheet 14. Because of various suspension periods, deferrals, etc., the FPSC follows in their price list approval process, the most current sheet number on file with the Commission is not always the price list page in effect. Consult the Check Sheet for the sheet currently in effect.
- C. Paragraph Numbering Sequence There are nine levels of paragraph coding. Each level of coding is subservient to its next higher level:

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#### PRICE LIST FORMAT SHEETS

D. Check Sheets - When a price list filing is made with the FPSC, an updated check sheet accompanies the prices list filing. The check sheet lists the sheets contained in the price list, with a cross reference to the current revision number. When new pages are added, the check sheet is changed to reflect the revision. All revisions made in a given filing are designated by an asterisk (\*). There will be no other symbols used on this page if these are the only changes made to it (i.e., the format, etc. remains the same, just revised revision levels on some pages). The price list user should refer t the latest check sheet to find out if a particular sheet is the most current on file with the FPSC.

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## SECTION 1 - TECHNICAL TERMS AND ABBREVIATIONS

- 1.1 Access Line An arrangement which connects the customer's location to a Universal Telecom, Inc. network switching center.
- 1.2 Company or Carrier Universal Telecom, Inc.
- 1.3 Customer the person, firm, corporation or other entity which orders service and is responsible for payment of charges due and compliance with the Company's price list regulations.
- 1.4 Day From 8:00 a.m. up to but not including 5:00 p.m. local time Sunday through Friday.
- 1.5 Evening From 5:00 p.m. up to but not including 11:00 p.m. local time Sunday through Friday.
- 1.6 FCC Federal Communications Charge
- 1.7 Holidays Universal Telecom, Inc.'s recognized holidays are New Year's Day, Memorial Day, July 4th, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas Day.
- 1.8 Night/Weekend From 11:00 p.m. up to but not including 8:00 a.m. Sunday through Friday, and 8:00 a.m. Saturday up to but not including 5:00 p.m. Sunday.

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#### SECTION 2 - RULES, REGULATIONS AND SERVICE OUALITY CRITERIA

2.0

- 2.1 Service Availability The entire calling area of Florida in which BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc., GTE South, Inc. and Sprint provide local exchange service.
- 2.2 Interruption of Service Service may be suspended if the account is not paid in full by the bill due date. There will be a ten (10) day written notice of service termination.
- 2.3 Service Restoration Suspended service may be restored by paying a restoration fee, along with the past due amount on the account paid in full.
- 2.4 Disconnection If the restoration fee and past due account balance is not paid in full within ten (10) days of the notice of terminated service date, the account will be disconnected.
- 2.5 Re-connection If an account has been disconnected, Re-connection can be obtained by paying the past due amount, in full, on the account and paying the new account service fees.
- 2.6 Deposits and Advance Payments No deposits are required. All accounts are prepaid thirty (30) days in advance.
