- 3. Under Gulf Power Company's proposed Good Cents Conversion Program, are customers likely to replace existing inefficient heating, ventilating, and air conditioning (HVAC) equipment only if it fails?
- 4. Is Gulf Power Company's proposed Good Cents Conversion Program an energy conservation program, or, rather, electricity competing with natural gas?

8. Has Gulf Power Company incorporated reasonable annual energy usage assumptions in its cost-effectiveness analysis?
9. Should the Commission approve Gulf Power Company's proposed Good Cents Conversion Program, including approval for cost recovery through the Energy Conservation Cost Recovery (ECCR) Clause?
10. Should the docket be closed?
