Issue 2: Should BellSouth's Motion for Reconsideration by the Full Commission of Order No. PSC-99-0658-FOF-TP be granted?

Recommendation: No. BellSouth has failed to identify any fact overlooked by the Commission or any point of law upon which the Commission made a mistake in rendering its decision. BellSouth's Motion should, therefore, be denied. Furthermore, the decision on the Motion should be made by the panel assigned to this case, not by the full Commission.

Issue 3: Should the Commission approve the parties' May 24, 1999, Joint Motion to Modify Portions of Order No. PSC-99-0658-FOF-TP?

Recommendation: Yes. The Commission should also direct the parties to file the confidential partial settlement agreement referenced in the Motion within 10 days of issuance of the Commission's Order from this recommendation.

Issue 4: Should this Docket be closed?

Recommendation: No. This Docket should remain open to address BellSouth's Petition on Proposed Agency Action regarding the PAA portion of Order No. PSC-99-0658-FOF-TP.
