## COMMENTS ON COLLOCATION STATUS OF SUPRA TELECOMMUNICATIONS & INFORMATION SYSTEMS, INC.

Pursuant to Commission notice issued June 18, 1999, Supra Telecommunications & Information Systems, Inc. ("Supra") hereby provides comments regarding its collocation status in the central offices that are subject to these proceedings with BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. (BellSouth).

## A. Statement of Basic Position

On May 21, 1999, BellSouth filed a motion seeking a six-week continuance of these proceedings in light of the FCC's Order No. 99-48, issued March 31, 1999. By Order No. PSC-99-1123-PCO-TL, the prehearing officer granted BellSouth's request for continuance. The purpose of the six-week continuance was to allow the parties to the proceedings the opportunity to provide BellSouth with new collocation requirements and for BellSouth to then evaluate these requirements and assess the space availability in each central office.

At this time, BellSouth has not provided Supra with the results of its central office space assessment. It is Supra's understanding that BellSouth will not release this information until the July 26, 1999 status conference. Therefore, Supra cannot, at this time, state what the correct course of action for these proceedings should be. In any event, Supra requests that the Commission act expeditiously to assure a speedy resolution of these matters.
