Hi Kay,

I understand the confusion and it still applies. I called the company and explained to them that the Dept of State has them listed as C.I.O., Inc. not CIO, Inc. There is also no fictitious filing registration to justify the d/b/a Family Home Phone Services.

The Company has plans to amend its corporate name to either C.I.O./Family Home Phone Services, Inc. or CIO/Family Home Phone Services, Inc. They were not sure which when I spoke to them.

At this point, just leave it as it is or change it to at least C.I.O., Inc. which is how the Dept. of State has them listed legally. I have plans to send a memo to RAR with the correct name as soon as the Company sends me the Corporate Name Change paperwork.
