NOTICE OF PROPOSED AGENCY ACTION
ORDER APPROVING ASSIGNMENT OF AND NAME CHANGE ON
INTEREXCHANGE TELECOMMUNICATIONS CERTIFICATE

BY THE COMMISSION:

NOTICE is hereby given by the Florida Public Service Commission that the action discussed herein is preliminary in nature and will become final unless a person whose interests are substantially affected files a petition for a formal proceeding, pursuant to Rule 25-22.029, Florida Administrative Code.

On May 17, 1999, Teligent, Inc. (Teligent) and Teligent Services, Inc. (Teligent Services) filed with this Commission a joint request for assignment of and name change on Interexchange Telecommunications (IXC) Certificate No. 4850 from Teligent to Teligent Services.

Teligent and Teligent Services have complied with Rule 25-24.473, Florida Administrative Code, regarding the assignment of IXC certificates. We find the assignment to be in the public interest and, therefore, approve the assignment. IXC Certificate No. 4850 shall be amended to reflect that Teligent Services is the holder of this certificate.

IXCs are subject to Chapter 25-24, Florida Administrative Code, Part X, Rules Governing Telephone Service Provided by Interexchange Telephone Companies. IXCs are also required to comply with all applicable provisions of Chapter 364, Florida Statutes, and Chapters 25-4, Florida Administrative Code.

Based on the foregoing, it is

ORDERED by the Florida Public Service Commission that the request for assignment of and name change on Interexchange Telecommunications Certificate No. 4850 from Teligent, Inc. to Teligent Services, Inc., is hereby approved. It is further

ORDERED that Teligent Services, Inc.'s Interexchange Telecommunications service Certificate No. 4850 is subject to the terms and conditions set forth in the body of this Order. It is further

ORDERED that Interexchange Telecommunications Certificate No. 4850 shall be amended to reflect that Teligent Services, Inc., is the holder of this certificate. It is further


ORDERED that this Order will serve as Teligent Services, Inc.'s certificate and that this Order should be retained as proof of certification and as evidence of the name change. It is further

NOTICE OF FURTHER PROCEEDINGS OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

In the absence of such a petition, this order shall become final and effective upon the issuance of a Consummating Order.

Any objection or protest filed in this docket before the issuance date of this order is considered abandoned unless it satisfies the foregoing conditions and is renewed within the specified protest period.
