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CASE BACKGROUND

On June 4, 1999, Tampa Electric Company (TECO) filed a petition for approval to modify the language in the penalty clause provisions of its interruptible rate schedules IS-1, IST-1, SBT-1, IS-3, IST-3, and SBT-3. This docket was opened to address TECO's petition. On July 27, 1999, the Commission voted to suspend TECO's proposed modifications. On August 3, 1999, prior to any Commission action on the merits of TECO's petition, TECO filed a notice of withdrawal of the petition.
