Dear Ms. Li:

This is a follow up to your letter dated July 2, 1999, concerning your request to cancel North American's pay telephone certificate. In your letter, you stated that the company has been inactive since January 1, 1998, therefore, there were no revenues to report. Unfortunately, I cannot recommend that the Commission grant North American a voluntary cancellation since the regulatory assessment fees (RAFs) have not been paid in full, plus there are past due statutory penalty and interest charges for previous years.

Because a pay telephone certificate remains active until it is canceled by the Commission, you are responsible for payment of regulatory assessment fees if the certificate remains active for any day during a calendar year. Although you stated the company has been inactive since January 1998, the company's certificate was active since we were not advised otherwise. According to the Division of Administration, your company owes \$195.59 in regulatory assessment fees, penalty, and interest charges. Details of the charges are provided below:

Year	Fee	Penalty	Interest	Comment
1991	Paid	\$19.97	\$5.71	Payment was due 1/30/92. Payment was made 2/29/92, thus penalty & interest charges apply. You owed \$28.53 in penalty, but only paid \$8.56. You did not pay any interest.

PLEASE NOTE: \$65.50 IS THE AMOUNT DUE IF YOUR PAYMENT IS POSTMARKED IN 07/99. IF IT IS POSTMARKED IN 08/99, THE AMOUNT DUE BECOMES \$66.00.
1999	\$50.00	N/A	N/A	Payment will be due 1/31/00. Although you stated that the company has been inactive since 1998, the minimum RAF is due until the certificate is canceled by the Commission.

The past due charges for 1991, 1997, and 1998 must be paid before the certificate can be voluntarily canceled. Payment should be mailed to: Division of Administration, Florida Public Service Commission, 2540 Shumard Oak Blvd., Tallahassee, FL 32399-0850. Once the Commission receives your payment, I will open a docket to voluntarily cancel North American's certificate with an effective date of July 2, 1999, the date you notified us.

Although the 1999 fee is not due at this time, you may go ahead and voluntarily pay the fee. Or, when you pay the past due charges, you may enclose a letter stating when you will pay the 1999 fee, which is required by rule (copy attached). Please respond in writing by August 10, 1999.

25-24.514 Cancellation of a Certificate.

- (1) The Commission may cancel a company's certificate for any of the following reasons:
 - (a) Violation of the terms and conditions under which the authority was originally granted;
 - (b) Violation of Commission rules or orders;
 - (c) Violation of Florida Statutes; or,
 - (d) Failure to provide service for a period of six (6) months.
- (2) If a certificated company desires to cancel its certificate, it shall request cancellation from the Commission in writing and shall provide the following with its request:
 - (a) Statement of intent and date to pay Regulatory Assessment Fee.
 - (b) Statement of why the certificate is proposed to be cancelled.
- (3) Cancellation of a certificate shall be ordered subject to the holder providing the information required by subsection (2).
