Staff should reconsider its recommendation to propose the clarifying amendment to Rule 25-6.049(5)(a) in the ongoing Docket No. 990188-EI - Generic Investigation Into Requirement for Individual Electric Metering by Investor-Owned Electric Utilities Pursuant to Rule 25-6.049(5)(a), Florida Administrative Code.
