Issue 2: What is the rate base of Bayside Utilities, Inc. at the time of transfer?

Recommendation: The combined rate base for the water and wastewater systems at the time of the transfer should be \$282,274, which is the net book value previously established by Order No. PSC-98-1269-FOF-SU.

Issue 3: Should a negative acquisition adjustment be approved?

Recommendation: No. The \$92,274 negative acquisition adjustment should not be included in the calculation of rate base for transfer purposes.
