RE: DOCKET NO. 990944-EM - Request by Kissimmee Utility Authority to add a "Due Diligence" clause to its General Rules and Regulations and to revise its customer billing and deposit practices.

Issue 1: Should the Commission approve the "Due Diligence" clause proposed by Kissimmee Utilities Authority (KUA)?

Recommendation: No. The Commission should decline to take action on the proposed tariff on the basis that the subject matter does not require Commission approval. The tariff should remain on file with the Commission as part of the official tariff of the utility.
