hearing. The Commission may rule on any such motions from the

At the hearing, all parties shall be given the opportunity to  
present testimony and other evidence on the issues identified by  
the parties at the prehearing conference held on November 17, 1999.  
All witnesses shall be subject to cross-examination at the  
conclusion of their testimony.


APPLICABLE STATUTES AND RULES
