ITEM 51 - OCTOBER 5, 1999 AGENDA CONFERENCE - REQUEST FOR DEFERRAL

On September 28, 1999, the Petitioners in Docket No. 990970-TP asked that Item 51 be deferred from the October 5, 1999, Agenda Conference. The Petitioners indicate that they have unavoidable conflicts and will be unable to attend. The Petitioners indicate that they wish to present oral argument on this item and ask that the Commission allow 20 minutes per side. In addition, the Petitioners acknowledge that there are no statutory deadlines for the resolution of this item. Therefore, they ask that the item be deferred to a later agenda.

Staff recommends that the request for deferral be granted. Staff recommends, however, that this item not be placed on the next scheduled agenda. Instead, staff asks that the item be deferred to the November 16, 1999, Agenda Conference. Staff notes that the Commission may reach a determination on the allotment of time for oral argument at a later date.
