As noted in the memorandum dated October 8, 1999, the prehearing officer for this docket granted the Florida Industrial Power Users Group's (FIPUG) motion for extension of time to file intervenor testimony. In granting FIPUG's motion, the prehearing officer extended the due date for all intervenor testimony until October 18, 1999, and extended the due date for all rebuttal testimony until October 29, 1999. Consistent with these extensions, the prehearing officer also extended the due date for staff testimony until October 18, 1999. The extension for staff testimony was inadvertently omitted from the October 8, 1999, memorandum. A written order reflecting this decision will be forthcoming.
