

FLORIDA POWER & LIGHT COMPANY'S  
ISSUES AND POSITIONS

1. What are the appropriate final environmental cost recovery true-up amounts for the period from October 1997 through December 1998?

**FPL:** \$678,159 overrecovery.

2. What are the estimated/actual environmental cost recovery true-up amounts for the period January, 1999 through December, 1999?

**FPL:** \$157,015 overrecovery.

3. What are the appropriate projected environmental cost recovery amounts for the period January, 2000 through December, 2000?

**FPL:** The total environmental cost recovery amount, adjusted for revenue taxes is \$13,395,287. This amount consists of \$14,019,901 of projected environmental cost for the period net of the prior period overrecovery and taxes. FPL requests recovery of \$12,800,000 consistent with Order No. PSC-99-0519-AS-EI, allocating between energy and demand using the same allocation ratios realized in the calculation of the \$13,395,287.

4. What should be the effective date of the new environmental cost recovery factors for billing purposes?

**FPL:** The new environmental cost recovery factors should become effective with customer bills for January 2000 through December 2000. This will provide 12 months of billing on the environmental cost recovery factors for all customers

5. What depreciation rates should be used to develop the depreciation expense included in the total environmental cost recovery true-up amounts to be collected during the period January, 2000 through December, 2000?

**FPL:** The depreciation rates used to calculate the depreciation expense should be the rates that are in effect during the period the allowed capital investment is in service.

6. What are the appropriate environmental cost recovery factors for the period January, 1999 through December, 1999 for each rate group?


