Dear Ms. Causseaux:

PSC consideration of my request for an Order of Indigency was apparently delayed for two-weeks and the process of "service" was delayed accordingly. There is no need to toll time since we are still well within the prescribed limits for timely service. However, while my "brief" was prepared, I was unable to consult with the counsel for the PSC in the interim, on the matter of preparation and submission of exhibits.

Accordingly, I am mailing my Initial Briefs on this date instead of on October 15, 1999 as originally planned, and will submit the exhibits as required for filing with the Initial Briefs, within two (2) weeks or ASAP after consultation with the PSC Counsel, whichever is more appropriate under the conditions imposed by the delay.

I must emphasize that this is an inconvenience, but not a problem for me, and I hope that it is not a problem for either the court or the PSC. I'm doing my best to comply with the Appellate Rules, but I do not have the capability or resources to match those of the government.
